You'll find your attention split by dizzying delights, as you simultaneously track live action and watch a multiscreen videoscape, created by the actors and used to illuminate a twisted tale of obsession-in-overdrive.

In this supercharged soap opera, a troubled mom searching for her missing daughter enters a maze of deceit and lies. The hilarious cast employs kaleidoscopic multitasking, precise choreography, and electrifying sonic blasts—plus "green screen" superimposition effects produced using digital home video cameras. Tumultuous, ridiculous, and mind-bending, *House of No More* reveals the savagely funny techno-savant sensibility that has made Big Art Group a hit of the international festival scene.
