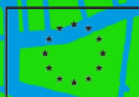

New steps towards Europe. Since August 2023, the Teatro Stabile Veneto – Teatro Nazionale has become one of the associated partners of “ [Fabulamundi Playwriting Europe](#) ”, a project that aims to support and promote contemporary playwriting at an international level.

From 17 to 19 October the TSV will host the 19 playwrights of the Fab community at the Goldoni Theater in Venice for the "Green Theater & Sustainability" workshop, three days of meetings dedicated to the themes of sustainability in the theater sector.

### What is Fabulamundi?

Fabulamundi is a project managed by PAV which boasts a network of collaborations spread across eighteen European countries.

Project born with the aim of creating an international, inclusive and supportive artistic community, through the “Fabulamundi New Voices”, a three-year training course aimed at new generations of European authors.

### What will be the program of the workshop?

The workshop will consist of a three-day gathering where the New Voices playwrights community will be involved in conversations, workshops and conferences focused on “Green” playwriting.

Issues regarding climate change, theatrical education tools and methods of community involvement will be addressed.

The meeting will bring together local speakers such as Dr. Giovanni Cecconi from Venice Lab and the Venice Sustainability Foundation, ETC experts Johann Otten, Dramaturg at Deutsches Theater Berlin, and Maura Meyer, Head of DT Jung - Deutsches Theater Berlin; and will include a preview of Big Art Group's "The Render" rehearsals at Arteterminal.
