COURSES:

Sarah Lawrence College - Beyond the Proscenium: Radical Acting, Directing, and Design in the Post-Internet Age

This is an immersive course designed for actors, performers, directors, designers, and writers who seek to push the boundaries of theater and embrace the bold world of post-internet aesthetics, where theatre and performance meet cutting-edge digital and networked methods. You'll investigate innovative approaches to contemporary theater, exploring new ways of storytelling that embrace technology's boundless possibilities. Through engaging exercises, thought-provoking readings, and inspiring discussions, you'll explore the fusion of theater with immersive multimedia elements.

Sarah Lawrence College - Digital Devising: Creating Theatre in a Post-digital World - Course explores the histories, methods, and futures of ensemble and co-authored performance creation with a focus on new skills and concepts of digital and post-internet. After an overview of historical devising companies, artists, concepts, and strategies, we will develop skill sets and frameworks for creating work in a lab setting using the formal aspects of digital and post-internet performance. Some of the frameworks

included are digital time; avatars and the double event; embodied and representational strategies in the uncanny valley; staging digital tools, interfaces, and structures; aspects of connectivity, politics, and economics; post-internet materiality; and using code to generate and control performances and creation of texts.

Sarah Lawrence College - Performance Research - Course investigates current and emerging practices in performing care, contemporary choreography, speculative theatre, immersive theatre, co-presence, performance cabaret, post-digital strategies, socially engaged art, and mixed reality performance.

Sarah Lawrence College - Embodied Thesis - Graduate Thesis class that creates a critical and supportive forum for the development of new works of original theatre with a focus on conducting research in a variety of ways, including historical and artistic research, workshops, improvisations, experiments, and conversation. Each creates one original project— a solo—over the course of the full year.

Sarah Lawrence College - Performance Lab - Course focuses on developing the skills needed for a wide variety of techniques for the creation and development of new work in theatre. Ensemble acting, movement, design and fabrication, playwriting, devised work, and music performance are all explored. The class is a forum for workshops, master classes, and open rehearsals, with a focus on the development of critical skills for creating ensemble driven original work.

Carnegie Mellon University - Future Stages - Contemporary techniques for ensemble creation and media integration are introduced and students develop works that combine digital imaging, composite, and live feed video with design, direction, and acting.

Carnegie Mellon University - Think Tank - This is a 6 semester research and development set of courses for MFA directors. The course consists of field research and writing, professional development, creativity exercises, and skill building in developing, proposing, pitching, fundraising, producing, touring, community organizing, and documenting work. The class also provides an ongoing forum on the art and craft of collaborating with playwrights, actors, designers, producers, and presenters.

Carnegie Mellon University S18 - Director's Lab - Social Engaged Art - Students research artists and artworks, discuss readings, volunteer with socially engaged Pittsburgh based not for profits, and develop, map, and propose their own socially engaged performance project.

Carnegie Mellon University F16 - Director's Lab - Post Internet Creation Strategies - Students research artists and artworks, discuss readings, and take part in creativity exercises to formulate strategies to work in the aesthetics of post-internet.

Carnegie Mellon University F15 - Director's Lab - Performing Materiality: Object Theater and Material Performance - Students research artists and artworks, discuss readings, creativity exercises, and take part in master workshops by guest artists to formulate strategies for making work that embraces materiality, puppetry, and object theater.

Carnegie Mellon University - Director Generator - Students develop adaptations from non-dramatic source material through writing exercises, group readings and feedback.

Carnegie Mellon University - Graduate Directing: New Works - 1st year graduate directing students collaborate with 2nd year playwrights and junior actors to further develop, rehearse and present the playwright's thesis production.

Carnegie Mellon University - Graduate Directing: Directors' Series Second Year - 2nd year graduate directing students pitch their production, collaborate with a design team of graduate and undergraduate designers, rehearse with undergraduate actors and graduate and undergraduate production team.
